CONTRACT FOR THE NEGOTIATED 53.1 - ONE (1) SET ICP MONITOR

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THIS CONTRACT ENTERED INTO THIS 2nd day of February 2024, BY AND BETWEEN:

The JOSE R. REYES MEMORIAL MEDICAL CENTER, a government hospital under the Department of Health of the Republic of the Philippines, with address at San Lazaro Compound, Rizal Avenue, Sta. Cruz, Manila, represented by its Medical Center Chief II, WENCESLAO S. LLAUDERES, MD, MPM-HG and hereinafter referred to as the "ENTITY"

and -

CENTRAL NEURO SYSTEMS TRADING CO. a corporation created under Philippine Law with office address at 1611, Malabon St. Sta. Cruz, Manila, herein represented by its General Manager, CHERYL M. SANTOS, and hereinafter referred to as the "SUPPLIER".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, a competitive bidding was conducted on 27 December 2023 by the Entity through the Hospital Bids and Awards Committee for the procurement NEGOTIATED 53.1 - ONE (1) SET ICP MONITOR hereinafter called the "ITEM."

WHEREAS, the "SUPPLIER" being the lowest calculated and responsive bidder which purchased the bidding documents submitted the specified requirements on the above-mentioned item and was found eligible during the preliminary examination of the bid last 27 December 2023. The SUPPLIER was awarded the project in the sum amount of TWO MILLION ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND PESOS (P2,150,000.00) only, inclusive of local taxes and the ENTITY has accepted the bid for the following particular/s:

WHEREAS, the Supplier, having the necessary resources and expertise, is willing and competent to provide the required items.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the premises and of terms and conditions hereinafter set forth, the parties hereby agree as follows:

Article I- SCOPE OF CONTRACT

- 1. In this Agreement words and expressions shall have the same meaning as are respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract referred to.
- 2. The following documents shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as part of this Agreement, viz.:
 - a. Hospital Bids and Awards Committee Resolution to Award no. 0141 s. 2024 (Annex 1);
 - b. Notice of Award (Annex 2);
 - c. Purchase Request No. 2023-07-6036 (Annex 3);
 - d. Certificate of Availability of Fund No. 2023-08-3795 (Annex 4);
 - e. Bid Bulletin (Annex 5);
 - f. The Bid Form and the Price Schedule submitted by the Bidder (Annex 6);
 - g. The Schedule of Requirements (Annex 7);
 - h. The Technical Specifications (Annex 8);
 - i. The General Conditions of Contract (Annex 9);
 - j. The Special Conditions of Contract (Annex 10);
 - k. The Abstract of Bids (Annex 11);
 - l. The Warranty (Annex 12);
 - m. The Performance Security (Annex 13);
 - n. Project Procurement Management Plan (Annex 14);
 - o. Annual Procurement Plan (Annex 15); and
 - p. Brochure (Annex 16).

ARTICLE II - EFFECTIVITY OF THE CONTRACT

The effectivity date of this contract is the date of the **SUPPLIER's** receipt of the Notice to Proceed (NTP) unless a different date is stated in the NTP.

The **SUPPLIER** shall deliver the **ITEM** within the period specified in the Notice to Proceed (NTP).

ARTICLE III- DURATION OF ENGAGEMENT

Unless sooner terminated, this Contract shall be valid for Thirty (30) calendar days from the receipt of Notice to Proceed (NTP).

ARTICLE IV- TERMS OF PAYMENT

- a) In consideration of the payments to be made by the Entity to the Supplier as hereinafter mentioned, the Supplier hereby covenants with the Entity to provide the goods and to remedy defects therein in conformity in all respects with the provisions of the Contract.
- b) The Entity hereby covenants to pay the Supplier in consideration of the provision of the goods and services and the remedying of defects therein, the Contract Price or such other sum as may become payable under the provisions of the contract at the time and in the manner prescribed by the contract.

ARTICLE V- SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

Any and all disputes arising from the implementation of this contract shall be submitted to arbitration in the Philippines according to the provisions of Republic Act (R.A) 876, otherwise known as the "Arbitration Law" and RA 9285 otherwise known as the "Alternative Dispute Resolution Act of 2004". Provided further, that by mutual agreement, the parties may agree in writing to resort to other alternative modes of disputes resolution.

ARTICLE VI-LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

When SUPPLIER fails to perform its obligation within the period as set in the Contract, **SUPPLIER** shall be liable for damages for the delay and shall indemnify the **ENTITY** liquidated damages in the amount equivalent to one-tenth (1/10) of one percent (1%) of the cost of the unperformed portion for everyday of delay. Provided, that such delay is not attributed to **ENTITY'S** failure to meet its obligation to **SUPPLIER**, or due to force majeure. Provided further that, in the event the cumulative amount of liquidated damages reaches ten percent (10%) of the amount of the contract, **ENTITY** may rescind or terminate the Contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies available with the circumstances.

ARTICLE VII- ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS

- a) It is understood that no employer-employee relationship exists between the **ENTITY** and **SUPPLIER** and/or the latter's staff or employees by reason of this Contract;
- b) Should the **ENTITY** be constrained to resort to court action to protect its right and interests hereunder, the **SUPPLIER** shall pay the **ENTITY** an amount equivalent to 20% of the total sum claimed in the complaint as and by way of attorney's fees plus expenses of litigation recoverable under pertinent laws provided, that the attorney's fees shall in no case be less than Twenty Thousand Pesos (Php20,000.00). Venue of such court action shall be laid exclusively in the proper court of Manila Philippines.
