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Best Practices:

- 1. In spite of the restrictions brought about by the Covid 19 pandemic, the MTRO was able to continue providing training programs to the staff with the use of the online platform Zoom. Scheduled interdepartmental Specialty, Morbidity & Mortality Conferences as well as the Tumor Board Conferences were continued online. The multi- disciplinary tumor board conferences were conducted weekly starting July 2021 from the previous schedule of 2 times a month. Improved attendance and active participation of each department with the support of their respective consultants were noted. Online webinars replaced face-to-face training programs.
- 2. The annual JRRMMC Interdepartmental Research Forum which has been held regularly still pushed through last November 2021, with good number of participants and improved quality of research outputs.
- 3. Virtual rotation of paramedical affiliates in Medical Technology, Physical Therapy and Occupational Therapy were started pending approval of face- to- face rotations.
- 4. Postgraduate medical interns started with virtual rotations last August 2021 but after receiving authorization from the CHED and the Bureau of Permits of the City of Manila, limited face to face rotations started last September 2021.
