Background:

NCR was at Alert level 2 for the whole month of February. Under the alert level, NCR was classified as low risk hence face to face consultation at OPD was allowed as per online (Tele-consultation) schedule with maximum of 10 patients per day for each department. Though under low risk classification, the public is still reminded to adhere to the minimum health standards protocol because there is still the risk of contacting the covid-19 virus.
