May 2021

Background:

For the month of May NCR's quarantine status is Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ) considering decreasing number of confirmed cases of Covid 19. But with intermittent increase in number of Covid 19 cases, our hospital is still observing limitations in the activities brought about by the high risks of transmissibility of the COVID-19 virus. There was still limitation in the delivery of health and limitations of face-to-face communication though with 1 day increase number of duty day/hours the Public Health, Emerging Disease and Wellness Unit managed to fulfill its obligations hence submits the following accomplishment:

I- Continuous linkage with DOH, Health Promotion Bureau (HPB0), DOH NCR MMCHD, HEPO links, to keep abreast with the pandemic and other DOH Health event as a guide in the conduct of health information /dissemination activities.
