1. TELEDERMATOLOGY

Objective:

- To provide online consultations among leprosy patients from far-flung ares who do not have access to transportation
- o To reduce leprosy relapse and resistance to multidrug therapy

Description of Activity:

 The dermatology residents provide free online consultation to leprosy patients from remote areas who are unable to have face-to-face consults at the OPD. New patients are also assessed and encouraged to seek consult at the OPD if highly suspected as a new case of leprosy.

Output:

 The patients are able to undergo regular follow-up online consultations to address their medical concerns.

2. REGULAR OUTPATIENT DEPARTMENT CONSULTATION



Objectives:

- o To provide regular consultation with leprosy patients
- To distribute medications among leprosy patients and prevent drug resistance
- To strengthen patient and community awareness on leprosy

Description of Activity:

The infectious clinic is open to patients during weekdays, 8 am to 5 pm despite the community quarantine to ensure that patients have easy access to consults and medications. The dermatology residents provide face-to-face consultations to patients who seek consult at the clinic.

Output:

 The leprosy patients are able to have follow-up consultations and get their medications on a regular basis. Lepra reaction kits and starter kits were distributed to patients.
